



Idioms	Meaning
 [shǒu zhū dài tù]	Wait every day under the tree, in the hope that a hare would kill itself by crashing into a tree trunk meaning wait for gains without pains.
 [shé xiē xīn cháng]	Have a heart as malicious as snakes and scorpions.
 [lóng mǎ jīng shén]	The vigour of a dragon or horse - vigorous spirit of the aged. Also means to constantly strive to become stronger constantly strive to become stronger.
 [dǎn xiǎo rú shǔ]	As timid [cowardly] as a mouse.
 [zhū gǒu bù rú]	Worse than pigs or dogs.
